The most difficult task consists in finding the exact moment when the balance tips in favour of creativity and the zone where in matters of artistic freedom the disadvantages outweigh the benefits This is what the twelve chapters of the volume proceed to do Thanks to a wide variety of examples they show that in the Elizabethan and Jacobean eras regulations seldom prevented writers to make themselves heard albeit through indirect channels By contrast in the 1630s the increased supremacy of the Church seemed to tip the balance the other way Freedom of the Press Nancy C.
