Partition of the Kingdom of Thera and conflicts everywhere. Apogee of Western Megalithism.

Indo-European are not the most favored in the final partition of the ancient Kingdom of Thera. Extreme secondary peoples, as Iberian Iberians and Almorian seem most favored. Nevertheless a small IE group, probably ancestor of Greeks, settled in the mountains. Paeonia instead experiences a rebirth, unified by the victorious peoples of Iberia. Eastern IEs (proto-Greeks) march over the Iberian region and the Caucasus, while their western mixed cousins see their influence weaken to decay under the powerful shadow of the Paeonian league and the Atlantic Megalithic religion. Nevertheless their legacy is still noticeable, possibly intervening in the Alpine rebellion against Michelsbergian authority. The echoes of these conflicts seem to extend to the SW, where the Ligurian confederation seems dissolved among parts of warriors.

Probably in Malta, Eastern megalithic traditions reach the Neolithic in this phase, rising new forms of tomb building ("tholos", artificial caves) that nevertheless don't lose the traditional defense that remains as the main security structure. Megalithism seems to be clearly integrated of collection and innovation of contemporary structures, a trait that overflows its limits, as well as advanced astronomical knowledge. In this period it reaches clearly beyond of the cultural boundaries of Western Iberia, maybe entering in conflict with the Iberian world, specially with Michelsberg.

Challenges the terrestrial focus of European prehistory emphasizing the significance of seascapes maritime networks and coastal societies in shaping prehistoric Europe For many years now the main thrust of European prehistory has followed a fundamentally terrestrial plot line This terrestrial paradigm has undervalued the story of Europe as a peninsula between the Baltic Mediterranean and Atlantic and likewise downplayed that of many navigable rivers that reach deeply inland and the large lakes important for travel and subsistence In vast areas of Europe the survival of incoming groups depended on coping and interacting with a seascape as much as a landscape From the late Mesolithic onwards in regions such as Scandinavia the British Isles and the Mediterranean most occupation was coastal seas or rivers provided the most important infrastructure for transport exchange and communication Know how about seascapes boatbuilding navigation and maritime networks had a profound impact on social organisation ritual monuments and iconography and the spread of materials and ideas enabled by the adaptation of languages to these new environments Given these facts the time is long overdue to critique the dominant terrestrial paradigm of European prehistory This book is the first in the multi author series Maritime Encounters outputs of the major six year 2022 2028 international research initiative funded by Sweden's central bank Our programme is based on a maritime perspective a counterpoint to prevailing land based vantages on Europe's prehistory In the Maritime Encounters project a highly international cross disciplinary team has embarked on a diverse range of research goals to provide a more detailed and nuanced story of how prehistoric societies realised major and minor sea crossings organised long distance exchange and adapted to ways of life by the sea in prehistory

Trypillia Mega-Sites and European Prehistory Johannes Müller, Knut Rassmann, Mykhailo Videiko, 2016-01-22 In European prehistory population agglomerations of more than 10 000 inhabitants per site are a seldom phenomenon A big surprise to the archaeological community was the discovery of Trypillia

mega sites of more than 250 hectares and with remains of more than 2000 houses by a multidisciplinary approach of Soviet and Ukrainian archaeology including aerial photography geophysical prospection and excavations nearly 50 years ago The extraordinary development took place at the border of the North Pontic Forest Steppe and Steppe zone ca 4100 3400 BCE Since then many questions arose which are of main relevance Why how and under which environmental conditions did Trypillia mega sites develop How long did they last Were social and or ecological reasons responsible for this social experiment Are Trypillia and the similar sized settlement of Uruk two different concepts of social behaviour Paradigm change in fieldwork and excavation strategies enabled research teams during the last decade to analyse the mega sites in their spatial and social complexity High precision geophysics target excavations and a new design of systematic field strategies deliver empirical data representative for the large sites Archaeological research contributed immensely to aspects of anthropogenic induced steppe development and subsistence concepts that did not reach the carrying capacities Probabilistic models based on 14C dates made the contemporaneity of the mega site house structures most probable In consequence Trypillia mega sites are an independent European phenomenon that contrasts both concepts of urbanism and social stratification that is seen with similar demographic figures in Mesopotamia The new Trypillia research can be read as the methodological progress in European archaeology

Geselowitz, 2013-11-11 During HaA HaB many settlements were established in Silesia and in the central part of Poland and their stability seems to be confirmed by the existence of regional groups and subgroups by long lasting colonies and by long used burial grounds located at large settlements At the end of HaB many pre Scythian elements occurred in this area only partly influenced by the Cimmerians During that period the peoples living north of the Carpathian and Sudeten Mountains remained very dependent on the productive and cultural circle south of the Carpathians with which they maintained strong connections The Lusatian settlement zone apart from its increasing internal stability also tended to extend its range A partition of the Lusatian Culture which had appeared earlier became more pronounced under the strong influence of the East Hallstatt cultural and productive center in the eastern Alpine region and the so called amber route The eastern zone of the Lusatian Culture remained under the influence of the Carpathian center while the western zone was strongly influenced by the pre Celtic Bylanska or Horakowska and northern Illyrian Calons denberian cultures In HaD2 ca 520 500 B C this latter area was the site of an armed incursion of Scythian groups coming from the east through the Karpacka Valley The most characteristic features of the western zone include its own varieties of more general Hallstatt traits such as fortified settlements which date from HaA in the Lusatian Culture production of iron done domestically since HaD and decorated pottery
