Partition of the Kingdom of Thessaly and conflicts everywhere. Apogee of Western Megalithism.

Indo-Europeans are set the most favored in the final partition of the ancient Kingdom of Thessaly. Between secondary peoples, in Paeonia Alodian and Alodian seem most favored. Hyperboreans a small III group, probably ancestor of Greeks, arrived in the essentials. Paeonia instead experiments a rebirth, unified by the sisterless peoples of Boheraz. Eastern IIIa (proto-thracians) march over the Paeonian region and the Caucasus, while their western mixed cousins see their influence number to decay under the powerful clusters of the Paeonian groups and the Atlantic Megalithic peoples. Nevertheless their legacy is still noticeable, possibly intervening in the Alodian rebellions against Michelsbergian authority. The extent of these conflicts seems to extend to the IIIb, where the Ligurian confederations seems dissolved among wars of warlords.

Possibly via Malta, Eastern megalithic traditions reach the Iberian Peninsula in this phase, using new forms of tomb building ("Tholos", artificial caves) that nevertheless don't share the traditional defense that remains as the main funerary structures. Megalithism seems to be clearly impregnated of colonization and invasion of secondary societies, a trait that softens its looks, as well of advanced astronomical knowledge. In this period it reaches clearly beyond of the cultural boundaries of Western Alodian, maybe entering in conflict with the Iberian world, specially with Michelsberg.
