Causal Analysis in Population Studies Henriette Engelhardt,Hans-Peter Kohler,Alexia Fürnkranz-Prskawetz,2009-05-05 The central aim of many studies in population research and demography is to explain cause effect relationships among variables or events For decades population scientists have concentrated their efforts on estimating the causes of effects by applying standard cross sectional and dynamic regression techniques with regression coefficients routinely being understood as estimates of causal effects The standard approach to infer the effects of causes in natural sciences and in psychology is to conduct randomized experiments In population studies experimental designs are generally infeasible In population studies most research is based on non experimental designs observational or survey designs and rarely on quasi experiments or natural experiments Using non experimental designs to infer causal relationships i e relationships that can ultimately inform policies or interventions is a complex undertaking Specifically treatment effects can be inferred from non experimental data with a counterfactual approach In this counterfactual perspective causal effects are defined as the difference between the potential outcome irrespective of whether or not an individual had received a certain treatment or experienced a certain cause The counterfactual approach to estimate effects of causes from quasi experimental data or from observational studies was first proposed by Rubin in 1974 and further developed by James Heckman and others This book presents both theoretical contributions and empirical applications of the counterfactual approach to causal inference **The United States since 1980** Dean Baker,2007-03-05 This book first published in 2007 describes the sharp right turn the United States has taken

Medical Care Economic Risk Panel on Measuring Medical Care Risk in Conjunction with the New Supplemental Income Poverty Measure, Committee on National Statistics, Division of Behavioral and Social Sciences and Education, Board on Health Care Services, National Research Council and Institute of Medicine, 2013-01-24 The United States has seen major advances in medical care during the past decades but access to care at an affordable cost is not universal Many Americans lack health care insurance of any kind and many others with insurance are nonetheless exposed to financial risk because of high premiums deductibles co pays limits on insurance payments and uncovered services One might expect that the U S poverty measure would capture these financial effects and trends in them over time Yet the current official poverty measure developed in the early 1960s does not take into account significant increases and variations in medical care costs insurance coverage out of pocket spending and the financial burden imposed on families and individuals Although medical costs consume a growing share of family and national income and studies regularly document high rates of medical financial stress and debt the current poverty measure does not capture the consequences for families economic security or their income available for other basic needs In 1995 a panel of the National Research Council NRC recommended a new poverty measure which compares families disposable income to poverty thresholds based on current spending for food clothing shelter utilities and a little more The panel s recommendations stimulated extensive collaborative research involving several government agencies on experimental poverty measures that led to a new research Supplemental Poverty Measure SPM which the U S Census Bureau first published in November 2011 and will update annually Analyses of the effects of including and excluding certain factors from the new SPM showed that were it not for the cost that families incurred for premiums and other medical expenses not covered by health insurance 10 million fewer people would have been poor according to the SPM The implementation of the patient Protection and Affordable Care Act ACA provides a strong impetus to think rigorously about ways to measure medical care economic burden and risk which is the basis for Medical Care Economic Risk As new policies whether part of the ACA or other policies are implemented that seek to expand and improve health insurance coverage and to protect against the high costs of medical care relative to income such measures will be important to assess the effects of policy changes in both the short and long term on the extent of financial burden and risk for the population which are explained in this report
