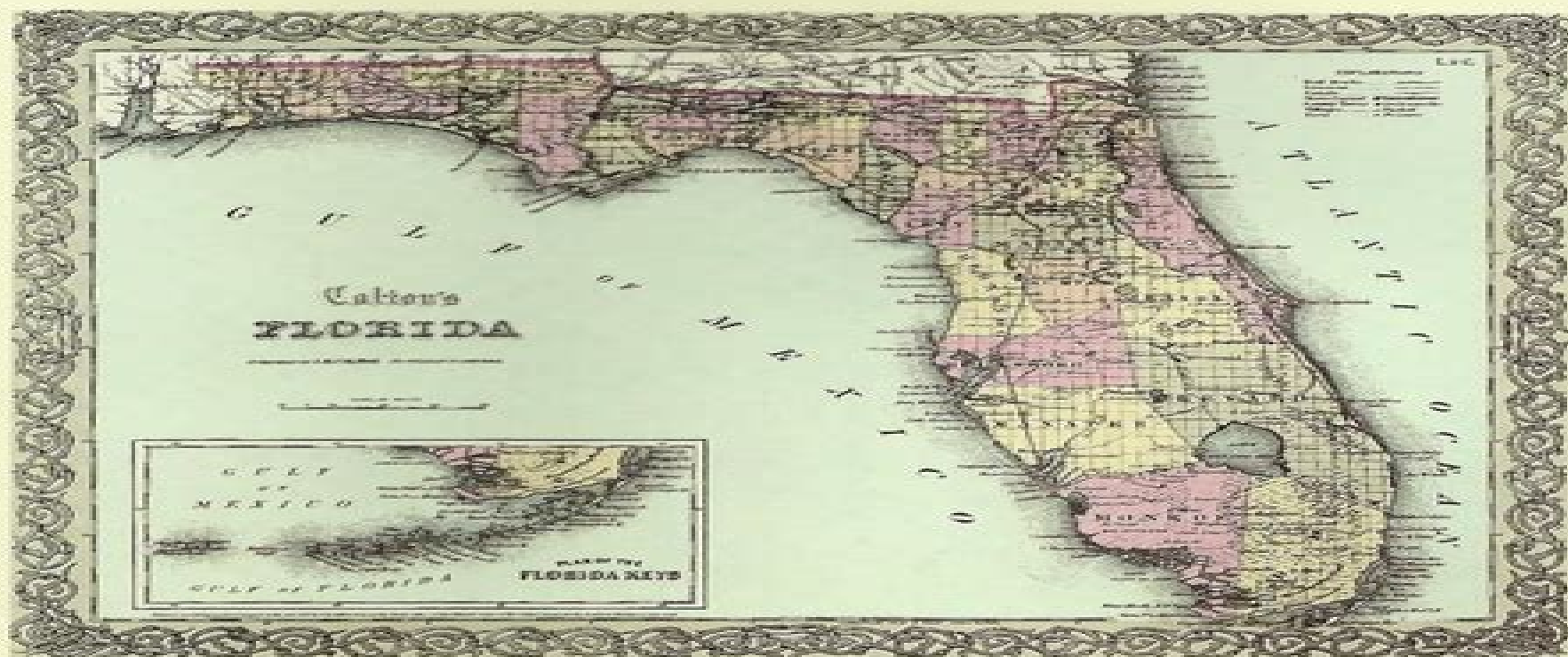

Echoes from a Distant Frontier Corinna Brown Aldrich, Ellen Brown Anderson, 2004 Echoes from a Distant Frontier is an edited annotated selection of the correspondence of Corinna and Ellen Brown two single women in their twenties who left a comfortable New England home in 1835 for the Florida frontier Within a month of their arrival the frontier erupted in Indian war The Browns witnessed the terror and carnage firsthand and their letters paint a vivid picture of the Second Seminole War 1835 1842 Teaching in Black and White Barbara E. Mattick, 2022-12-13 Teaching in Black and White The Sisters of St Joseph in the American South discusses the work of the Sisters of St Joseph of the city of St Augustine who came to Florida from France in 1866 to teach newly freed blacks after the Civil War and remain to this day It also tells the story of the Sisters of St Joseph of Georgia who sprang from the motherhouse in St Augustine A significant part of the book is a comparison of the Sisters of St Josephs work against that of their major rivals missionaries from the Protestant American Missionary Association Using letters the Sisters wrote back to their motherhouse in France the book provides rare glimpses into the personal and professional lives of these women religious in St Augustine and other parts of Florida and Georgia from the mid nineteenth century through the era of anti Catholicism in the early twentieth century South It carries the story through 1922 the end of the pioneer years of the Sisters of St Josephs work in Florida and the end of Sisters of St Joseph of Georgia s existence as a distinct order Through the lenses of Catholicism Florida and Southern history gender and race the book addresses the Protestant concept of domesticity and how it was reinforced in Catholic terms by women who seemingly defied the ideal It also relates the Sisters contributions in shaping life in the South during Reconstruction as they established elite academies and free schools created orphanages ministered to all during severe yellow fever epidemics and fought the specter of anti Catholicism as it crept across the rural regions of the country To date little has been written about Catholics in the South much less the women religious who served there This book helps to fill that gap Teaching in Black and White provides rare glimpses into the personal and professional lives of women religious in Florida and Georgia from the mid nineteenth to early twentieth century The Florida Historical Quarterly Florida Historical Society, 2005 **A New Vision of Southern Jewish History** Mark K. A New Vision of Southern Jewish History contains Bauman's studies of Jewish urbanization, acculturation, and migration; intra and inter group relations; economics and business; government, civic affairs, transnational diplomacy, social services, and gender, all complicating traditional notions of southern Jewish identity. Drawing on role theory as informed by sociology, psychology, demographics, and the nature and dynamics of leadership, Bauman traverses a broad swath, often urban, of the southern landscape from Savannah, Charleston, and Baltimore through Atlanta, New Orleans, Galveston, and beyond the country to Europe and Israel. Bauman's retrospective volume gives readers the opportunity to review a lifetime of work in a single publication, as well as peruse newly penned introductions to his essays. The book also features an Additional Readings section designed to update the historiography in the essays.

Religion in the Contemporary South Corrie Norman (E.), Donald S. Armentrout, 2005. Religion has always been crucial to the cultural identity of the South. The field of southern religious studies is quite young, however, and most scholarship has focused on the kinds of evangelical fundamentalist activity for which the phrase Bible Belt was coined. *Religion in the Contemporary South* is the first book to fully address the emerging religious pluralism in the South today. Featuring an introduction by Samuel S. Hill, *Religion in the Contemporary South* brings together fourteen essays by both established and emerging scholars that deal with a spectrum of topics. These topics include religious identities in the South that weave in and out of the past, new religious expressions in the South, and the shifting position of old minority traditions, and a microcosmic look at the Episcopal Church. Leonard talks about the future of the Baptist denomination, which grows more uncertain as moderates break ties with the fundamentalist leaders of the Southern Baptist Convention. In *Our Lady of Guadeloupe Visits the Confederate Memorial*, Thomas Tweed notes the growth of Hindu, Buddhist, and Muslim traditions in the South. Susan Ridgely Bales examines the state of southern Catholicism in *Sweet Tea and Rosary Beads*, and in *Quiet Revolutionaries*, D. Jonathan Grieser. Corrie E. Norman and Don S. Armentrout discuss the ways in which women priests in the Southern Episcopal Church construct their lives and callings. These and other offerings are varied.

Rebels and Runaways Larry E. Rivers, 2012-06-22 This gripping study examines slave resistance and protest in antebellum Florida and its local and national impact from 1821 to 1865 Using a variety of sources such as slaveholders wills and probate records ledgers account books court records oral histories and numerous newspaper accounts Larry Eugene Rivers discusses the historical significance of Florida as a runaway slave haven dating back to the seventeenth century and explains Florida s unique history of slave resistance and protest In moving detail Rivers illustrates what life was like for enslaved blacks whose families were pulled asunder as they relocated from the Upper South to the Lower South to an untamed place such as Florida and how they fought back any way they could to control small parts of their own lives Against a smoldering backdrop of violence this study analyzes the various degrees of slave resistance from the perspectives of both slave and master and how they differed in various regions of antebellum Florida In particular Rivers demonstrates how the Atlantic world view of some enslaved blacks successfully aided their escape to freedom a path that did not always lead North but sometimes farther South to the Bahama Islands and Caribbean Identifying more commonly known slave rebellions such as the Stono Louisiana Denmark Vesey Gabriel and the Nat Turner insurrections Rivers argues persuasively that the size scope and intensity of black resistance in the Second Seminole War makes it the largest sustained slave insurrection ever to occur in American history Meticulously researched **Rebels and Runaways** offers a detailed account of resistance protest and violence as enslaved blacks fought for freedom

Father James Page Larry Eugene Rivers, 2021-02-02 This first of its kind biography tells the story of Rev James Page who rose from slavery in the nineteenth century to become a religious and political leader among African Americans as well as an international spokesperson for the cause of racial equality Winner of the Rembert Patrick Award by The Florida Historical Society Florida Non Fiction Book Award by the Florida Book Awards Harry T and Harrietter V Moore Award by the Florida Historical Society James Page spent the majority of his life enslaved during which time he experienced the death of his free father witnessed his mother and brother being sold on the auction block and was forcibly moved 700 miles south from Richmond VA to Tallahassee FL by his enslaver John Parkhill Page would go on to become Parkhill s chief aide on his plantation and unusually a religious leader who was widely respected by enslaved men and women as well as by white clergy educators and politicians Rare for enslaved people at the time Page was literate and left behind ten letters that focused on his philosophy as an enslaved preacher and later as a free minister educator politician and social justice advocate In **Father James Page** Larry Eugene Rivers presents Page as a complex conflicted man neither a nonthreatening

accommodationist mouthpiece for white supremacy nor a calculating schemer fomenting rebellion Rivers emphasizes Page's agency in pursuing a religious vocation in seeking to exhibit manliness in the face of chattel slavery and in pushing back against the overwhelming power of his enslaver Post emancipation Page continued to preach and to advocate for black self-determination and independence through black land ownership political participation and business ownership The church he founded Bethel Missionary Baptist Church in Tallahassee would go on to be a major political force not only during Reconstruction but through today Based upon numerous archival sources and personal papers as well as an in-depth interview of James Page and a reflection on his life by a contemporary this deeply researched book brings to light a fascinating life filled with contradictions concerning gender education and the social interaction between the races Rivers biography of Page is an important addition and corrective to our understanding of black spirituality and religion political organizing and civic engagement

Far East, Down South Raymond A. Mohl, John E. Van Sant, Chizuru Saeki, 2016-10-25 Offers a collection of ten insightful essays that illuminate the little known history and increasing presence of Asian immigrants in the American southeast In sharp contrast to the melting pot reputation of the United States the American South with its history of slavery Jim Crow and the civil rights movement has been perceived in stark and simplistic demographic terms In *Far East Down South* editors Raymond A Mohl John E Van Sant and Chizuru Saeki provide a collection of essential essays that restores and explores an overlooked part of the South's story that of Asian immigration to the region These essays form a comprehensive overview of key episodes and issues in the history of Asian immigrants to the South During Reconstruction southern entrepreneurs experimented with the replacement of slave labor with Chinese workers As in the West Chinese laborers played a role in the development of railroads Japanese farmers also played a more widespread role than is usually believed Filipino sailors recruited by the US Navy in the early decades of the twentieth century often settled with their families in the vicinity of naval ports such as Corpus Christi Biloxi and Pensacola Internment camps brought Japanese Americans to Arkansas Marriages between American servicemen and Japanese Korean Filipina Vietnamese and nationals in other theaters of war created many thousands of blended families in the South In recent decades the South is the destination of internal immigration as Asian Americans spread out from immigrant enclaves in West Coast and Northeast urban areas Taken together the book's essays document numerous fascinating themes the historic presence of Asians in the South dating back to the mid nineteenth century the sources of numerous waves of contemporary Asian immigration to the South and the steady spread of Asians out from the coastal port cities *Far East Down South* adds a vital new dimension to popular understanding of southern history

Huneycutt, 2024-05-14 This book collects previously unpublished letters written by a merchant in north Florida before the Civil War offering a view of the region s transformation to a market economy due in part to its increased reliance on slavery

Emancipation Betrayed Paul Ortiz, 2005-03-29 In this penetrating examination of African American politics and culture Paul Ortiz throws a powerful light on the struggle of black Floridians to create the first statewide civil rights movement against Jim Crow Concentrating on the period between the end of slavery and the election of 1920 Emancipation Betrayed vividly demonstrates that the decades leading up to the historic voter registration drive of 1919 20 were marked by intense battles during which African Americans struck for higher wages took up arms to prevent lynching forged independent political alliances boycotted segregated streetcars and created a democratic historical memory of the Civil War and Reconstruction Contrary to previous claims that African Americans made few strides toward building an effective civil rights movement during this period Ortiz documents how black Floridians formed mutual aid organizations secret societies women s clubs labor unions and churches to bolster dignity and survival in the harsh climate of Florida which had the highest lynching rate of any state in the union African Americans called on these institutions to build a statewide movement to regain the right to vote after World War I African American women played a decisive role in the campaign as they mobilized in the months leading up to the passage of the Nineteenth Amendment The 1920 contest culminated in the bloodiest Election Day in modern American history when white supremacists and the Ku Klux Klan violently and with state sanction prevented African Americans from voting Ortiz s eloquent interpretation of the many ways that black Floridians fought to expand the meaning of freedom beyond formal equality and his broader consideration of how people resist oppression and create new social movements illuminate a strategic era of United States history and reveal how the legacy of legal segregation continues to play itself out to this day

Denham, Edgar Canter Brown, Jr., 2023-04-13 Wild and wooly recollections from the Florida frontier Cracker Times and Pioneer Lives brings together the reminiscences of two pioneers who came of age in antebellum Florida s Columbia County and the nearby Suwannee River Valley Though they held markedly different positions in society they shared the adventure thrill hardship and tragedy that characterized Florida s pioneer era With sensitivity poignancy and humor George Gillett Keen and Sarah

Pamela Williams record anecdotes and memories that touch upon important themes of frontier life and reveal the remarkable diversity of Florida's settlers. Keen's story typifies that of many Cracker families. Born in Georgia, he moved with his parents to the Florida Territory in 1830 in search of a better life. He grew up in a dangerous yet exciting setting and as an old man at the turn of the twentieth century recorded his colorful memories with a verve and vernacular reminiscent of the Georgia humorist Augustus Baldwin Longstreet. Keen writes about subsistence farming, cattle grazing, the Seminole wars, marriage customs, medical practices, politics, the abundance of wildlife, and the paucity of educational opportunities. Admittedly not a Cracker, Sarah Pamela Williams was the daughter of a nationally recognized man of letters. In 1847 she moved to Columbia County's seat of Alligator Lake City and later married into one of northeast Florida's prominent planter families. She recorded her recollections of a life brightened by social functions, travel, and cultural endeavors. Offering a rare glimpse into Florida's Civil War homefront, Williams tells of making clothes of homespun, tithing crops to the Confederacy, fearing hostilities just thirteen miles from her home, and surviving as a widow in the lean postwar era. *Cracker Times* and *Pioneer Lives* features biographical sketches of more than 280 persons mentioned by Keen and Williams in their writings, many of whom subsequently pioneered settlement in the Florida peninsula. After the Civil War, the South was divided into five military districts occupied by Union forces. Out of these regions, a remarkable group of writers emerged. Experiencing the long-lasting ramifications of Reconstruction firsthand, many of these writers sought to translate the era's promise into practice.
