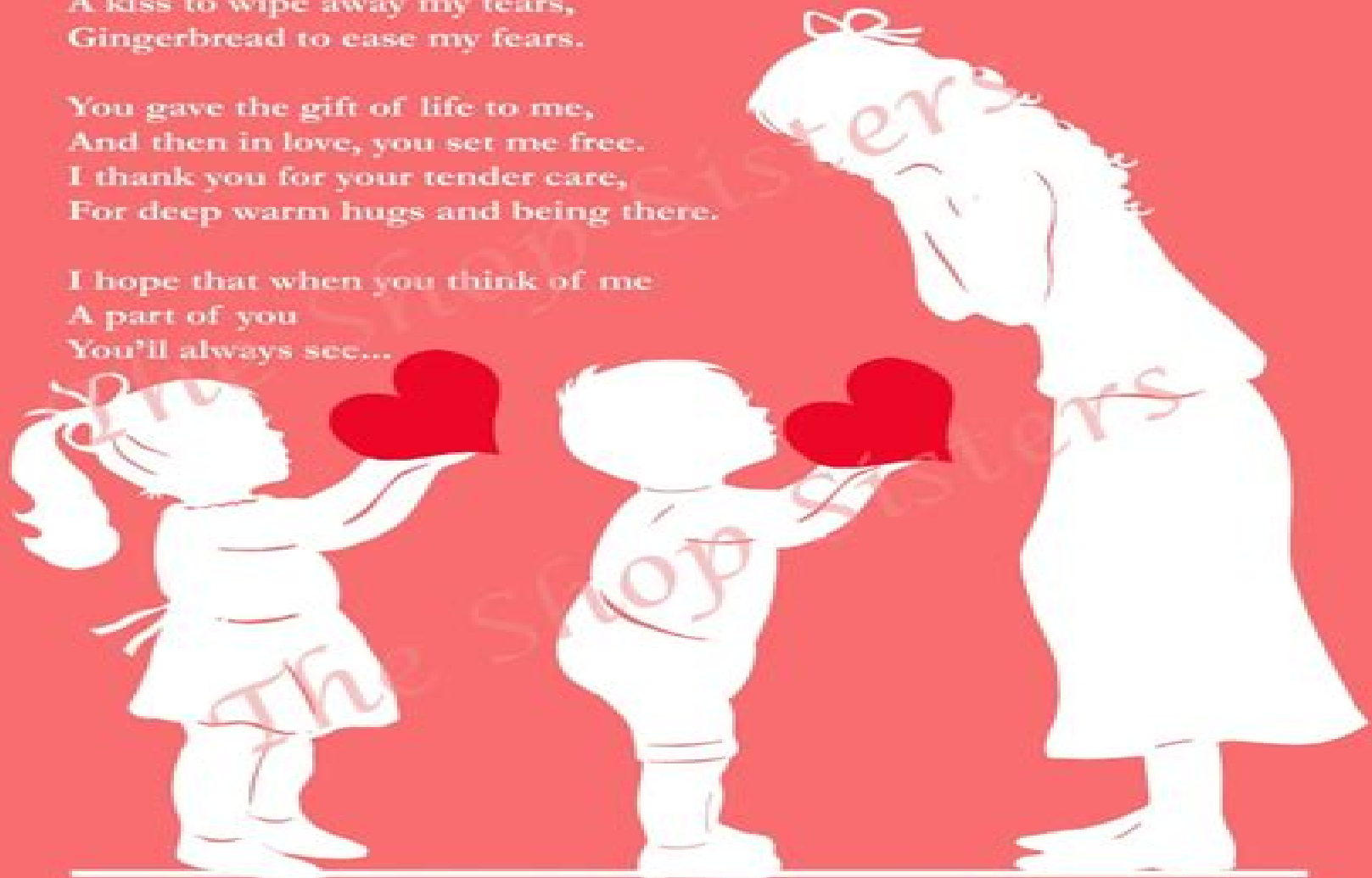


Mother
