Orlando, Ara Jo, Velyn Wu, 2025-05-21 Body composition like excess adiposity and muscle mass has been shown to be associated with the risk of diseases including diabetes cancer and cardiovascular disease Moreover body composition is directly associated with mortality risk Consequently assessment of a patient's body composition is one of the most common risk stratification variables that is collected In particular body mass index BMI is assessed for essentially every adult and is used to drive treatment decisions However BMI which is easy to measure in a doctor's office and a standard measurement to define obesity has been shown to have some limitations as a risk predictor for different populations For example BMI is not as predictive in Asian populations who may have a higher proportion of visceral fat and increased risk of cardiometabolic disorder Similarly as patients age they tend to lose lean muscle mass which may contribute to disease risk and healthy patients with a muscular physique may have an elevated BMI This has led to concepts like sarcopenic obesity and normal weight obesity BMI is a screening tool and clinicians should be aware of proper use of BMI when counselling patients and other assessments of body composition The Future of Flesh: A Cultural Survey of the Body K.
