murder to the virulent nineteenth century anti Mormonism that also took the life of prophet Joseph Smith and to an enduring southern tradition of extralegal violence In these writings the stories of the men who took Standing's life are largely ignored and they are treated as significant only as vigilantes who escaped justice Historian Mary Ella Engel adopts a different approach arguing that the mob violence against Standing was a local event best understood at the local level Her examination of Standing's murder carefully situates it in the disquiet created by missionaries successes in the North Georgia community As Georgia converts typically abandoned the state for Mormon colonies in the West a disguiet situated within a wider narrative of post Reconstruction Mormon outmigration to colonies in the West In this rich context the murder reveals the complex social relationships that linked North Georgians families kin neighbors and coreligionists and illuminates how mob violence attempted to resolve the psychological dissonance and gender anxieties created by Mormon missionaries In laying bare the bonds linking Georgia converts to the mob Engel reveals Standing's murder as more than simply mountain lawlessness or religious persecution Rather the murder responds to the challenges posed by the separation of converts from their loved ones especially the separation of women and their dependents from heads of households Handbook of Race and the Arts in Education Amelia M.
