appeared to confirm these fears The French Revolution had terrified similar royal regimes in other European empires and as the revolution took on ever bloodier connotations other countries were drawn into conflict with the new French Republic with the Holy Roman Empire on the front line of the revolutionary wars Napoleon Bonaparte earned his reputation with a number of victories on the battlefield and rose to the pinnacle of power in France As the French emperor his reign was characterized by a more aggressive military strategy and the rapid annexation of much of Europe
