united as refugees this unity did not lead to a unity in art refugee art is a construction put forward by the British press and the refugee organisations particularly the Free German League of Culture Second contrary to claims that modern art was international and formed a universal unity that transgressed nationality neither the West Europe nor modernism form unities instead in the 1930s and 1940s cultures in Europe constructed conceptions of other European cultures on the basis of nation state identities
