Girls have a **higher chance** for sports-related concussion than boys in sports that use the **same rules**, like soccer and basketball.

You can protect young female athletes by learning about concussion signs and symptoms, keeping an eye out for unique risks, and advocating for policies that **prioritize athlete safety for everyone**.

Girls may be **more likely** to report a sports-related concussion than boys.

MENTAL HEALTH

Concussion symptoms that affect mental health are **more common** in girls.

RESEARCH

Fewer research studies focus on sports-related concussion among girls than boys.

SYMPTOMS

Girls are **more likely** than boys to report severe and long-lasting symptoms following a sports-related concussion.

CARE

Healthcare providers, including athletic trainers, are **less likely** to be present at the time of girls' sports-related concussions than boys.
