and what does this mean The concept of falsification as a deductive method was brought up and made popular by the Austro British philosopher Karl Popper in the 1930s In contrast to the idea of gaining truth or principles through a lot of empiric observations inductive method he claimed that it is logically only possible to refute general statements by empirical observations Consequently Popper advocates for a method of research through trial and error Science should use the method of falsification and for him the use of it is the demarcation criterion between science and non science Karl Popper s methodological writings have been a cause of debate since the 1930s This scientific method is nowadays established particularly in natural sciences where you can tell more easily if a theory is wrong than in other disciplines Economic research is part of the second group of disciplines where we often find huge differences between Popper s prescriptions and the common practice and where normative statements are often part of all considerations
