Heads, Hides and Horns Larry Barsness, 2013-05-31 This thoroughly researched and superbly written book combines history myth folklore and fiction to tell the story not only of the buffalo but of the relationship between buffalo and man on the North American continent Synthesizing larger and longer histories of this unique animal this book traces the history of the buffalo from the time it led man to North America fed him clothed him and housed him As buffalo increased in numbers they became central to the culture of the Great Plains Indians who lived surrounded by them Much of the Indian way of life was related to knowledge of and reverence for the buffalo When the European white man arrived he lived off the buffalo as he explored the continent Later he slaughtered the great herds of animals when they trampled his crops stopped his railway trains and fed the Indians who fought him for the land But when extinction threatened the buffalo the white man was challenged by the idea of saving the animal an idea that captures the imagination of Americans yet today **Heads Hides Horns** traces this major history in a thousand small stories with directions for tanning recipes for cooking stories of tenderfeet and hide hunters Metis from Canada who searched for bones ciboleros from Mexico who hunted buffalo in Texas and hundreds of anecdotes and first person accounts Over one hundred illustrations accompany the lively text The pictorial research behind this book is as thorough as the textual study and the illustrations include works by major artists of the period Karl Bodmer and Frederic Remington for example along with actual period photographs Combining the best of art and history told in an anecdotal and readable manner **Heads Hides Horns** offers fascinating reading for anyone interested in the American West its culture traditions and ecology

Heads, Hides and Horns Larry Barsness, 1985 **Interrupted Odyssey** Mary Stockwell, 2018-09-12 In this first book devoted to the genesis failure and lasting legacy of Ulysses S Grant s comprehensive American Indian policy Mary Stockwell shows Grant as an essential bridge between Andrew Jackson s pushing Indians out of the American experience and Franklin D Roosevelt s welcoming them back in Situating Grant at the center of Indian policy development after the Civil War **Interrupted Odyssey** Ulysses S Grant and the American Indians reveals the bravery and foresight of the eighteenth president in saying that Indians must be saved and woven into the fabric of American life In the late 1860s before becoming president Grant collaborated with Ely Parker a Seneca Indian who became his first commissioner of Indian affairs on a plan to rescue the tribes from certain destruction Grant hoped to save the Indians from extermination by moving them to reservations where they would be guarded by the U S Army and welcoming them into the nation as American citizens By so doing he would restore the executive branch s traditional authority over Indian policy that had been upended by Jackson In **Interrupted Odyssey** Stockwell rejects the common claim in previous Grant scholarship that he handed the reservations over to Christian missionaries as part of his original policy In part because Grant s plan ended political patronage Congress overturned his policy by disallowing Army officers from serving in civil posts abandoning the treaty system and making the new Board of Indian Commissioners the supervisors of the Indian service Only after Congress

banned Army officers from the Indian service did Grant place missionaries in charge of the reservations and only after the board falsely accused Parker of fraud before Congress did Grant lose faith in his original policy Stockwell explores in depth the ousting of Parker revealing the deep seated prejudices that fueled opposition to him and details Grant's stunned disappointment when the Modoc murdered his peace commissioners and several tribes the Comanche Kiowa Cheyenne and Sioux rose up against his plans for them Though his dreams were interrupted through the opposition of Congress reformers and the tribes themselves Grant set his country firmly toward making Indians full participants in the national experience In setting Grant's contributions against the wider story of the American Indians Stockwell's bold thoughtful reappraisal reverses the general dismissal of Grant's approach to the Indians as a complete failure and highlights the courage of his policies during a time of great prejudice

Barrow, Jr., 2021-08-10 In the decades following the Civil War as industrialization urbanization and economic expansion increasingly reshaped the landscape many Americans began seeking adventure and aesthetic gratification through avian pursuits By the turn of the century hundreds of thousands of middle and upper class devotees were rushing to join Audubon societies purchase field guides and keep records of the species they encountered in the wild Mark Barrow vividly reconstructs this story not only through the experiences of birdwatchers collectors conservationists and taxidermists but also through those of a relatively new breed of bird enthusiast the technically oriented ornithologist In exploring how ornithologists struggled to forge a discipline and profession amidst an explosion of popular interest in natural history *A Passion for Birds* provides the first book length history of American ornithology from the death of John James Audubon to the Second World War Barrow shows how efforts to form a scientific community distinct from popular birders met with only partial success The founding of the American Ornithologists Union in 1883 and the subsequent expansion of

advocate He turned the sportsmen s journal Forest and Stream into a bully pulpit for wildlife protection forest reserves and national parks In 1886 his distress over the loss of bird species prompted him to found the first Audubon Society Next he and Theodore Roosevelt founded the Boone and Crockett Club to promote fair chase of big game His influence among the rich and the patrician provided leverage for the first federal legislation to protect migratory birds a precedent that ultimately paved the way for the Endangered Species Act And in an era when too many white Americans regarded Native Americans as backwards Grinnell s cries for reform carried from the reservation through the halls of Congress all the way to the White House Drawing on forty thousand pages of Grinnell s correspondence and dozens of his diaries Taliaferro reveals a man whose deeds and high mindedness earned him a lustrous peerage from presidents to chiefs Audubon to Aldo Leopold John Muir to Gifford Pinchot Edward S Curtis to Edward H Harriman Throughout his long life Grinnell was bound by family and sustained by intimate friendships toggling between the East and the West As Taliaferro s enthralling portrait demonstrates it was this tension that wound Grinnell s nearly inexhaustible spring and honed his vision a vision that still guides the imperiled future of our national treasures
