China's New Public Health Insurance Armin Müller, 2016-11-25. Especially since the 2003 SARS crisis China's healthcare system has become a growing source of concern both for citizens and the Chinese government. China's once praised public health services have deteriorated into a system driven by economic constraints in which poor people often fail to get access and middle income households risk to be dragged into poverty by the rising costs of care. The New Rural Cooperative Medical System (NRCMS) was introduced to counter these tendencies and constitutes the main system of public health insurance in China today. This book outlines the nature of the system, traces the processes of its enactment and implementation and discusses its strengths and weaknesses. It argues that the contested nature of the fields of health policy and social security has long been overlooked and reinterprets the NRCMS as a compromise between opposing political interests.
