THE U. S. ARMY PLAYED AN IMPORTANT part in our expansion into the Southwest in the nineteenth century. Between the Mexican and Civil wars it was busy developing this region and making it an integral part of the nation. It was actively engaged in establishing military posts, surveying routes for railroads, constructing wagon roads, protecting overland migration and overland mail, surveying boundaries of territories, overawing the Mormons, and fighting hostile Indians. These activities are well portrayed in the letters and journal of Eugene Bandel of the Sixth U. S. Infantry. These documents are here published for the first time.

Eugene Bandel, born in Prussia 1835, was an educated and keen observer. He enlisted at Jefferson Barracks, Missouri, 1854. He tramped nearly 6,000 miles over the plains and mountains of the Far West, serving under such prominent officers as Joseph E. Johnston,
