examining an anatomy more psychological spiritual and emotional than physical He painted many townscapes landscapes formal portraits and allegorical subjects but it was his extremely candid works on paper which are sometimes overtly erotic together with his penchant for using under age models that made Schiele vulnerable to censorious morality In 1912 he was imprisoned on suspicion of a series of offences including kidnapping rape and public immorality.
