Emily Dickinson's Open Folios Emily Dickinson, Marta L. Werner, 1995 Undertakes a radically new model of critical editing *Reading the Fascicles of Emily Dickinson* Eleanor Elson Heginbotham, 2003 Heginbotham's book focuses on Emily Dickinson's work as a deliberate writer and editor The fascicles were forty small portfolios of her poems written between 1856 and 1864 composed on four to seven stationery sheets folded stacked and sewn together with twine What revelations might come from reading her poems in her own context Are they simply scrapbooks as some claim or are they evidence of conscious canny editing Read in their original places each lyric becomes different and more interesting than when read in isolation We cannot know why Dickinson compiled the books or what she thought of them but we can observe what she left in them What she left is visible only by noting the way the poem answers in a dialogue across the pages the way lines spilling onto a second page introduce the next poem the way openings suggest image clusters so that each book has its own network of concerns and language not a story or philosophical preachment but an aesthetic wholeness This book is the first to demonstrate that Dickinson's poetic and philosophical creativity is most startling when the reader observes the individual lyric in the poet's own and only context for them For teacher student scholar and poetry lover Heginbotham creates an important new framework for understanding one of the most complex clever and profound U S poets *Voice, Text, Hypertext* Raimonda Modiano, Leroy F. problems clues or challenges to interpretation they continue to present Kathryn Sutherland goes on to consider the absence of a satisfactory critical theory of biography that can help us address the partial life and ends with a discussion of the screen adaptations through which the texts continue to live on Throughout Jane Austen's textual identities provide a means to explore the wider issue of what text is and to argue the importance of understanding textual space as itself a powerful agent established only by recourse to further interpretations and fictions
