As an alternative to an exhausted debate, Martínez San Miguel uses Gilles Deleuze and Félix Guattari's notion of a minor literature along with current studies on minority discourse to propose new close readings of texts by Hernán Cortés, Alvar Núñez Cabeza de Vaca, the Inca Garcilaso de la Vega, Carlos de Sigüenza y Gongora, and Sor Juana Inés de la Cruz. *From Lack to Excess* traces a discursive voyage that configures a linguistic matrix from the initial lack of language to the excessive Baroque representation of American reality.
