KEY POINTS

- Preterm and other infants needing intensive care after birth are at increased risk for health and developmental problems in infancy, childhood, and later life.
- Specialized follow-up programs provide periodic health and developmental surveillance and link infants with needed therapeutic services and supports.
- There is no standard of follow-up care for high-risk infants.
- The future of follow-up will focus on infant and family needs, address gaps in the equitable distribution of postdischarge services, and provide training and support for all members of the care team including clinicians, early intervention providers, and educators.

INTRODUCTION

Infants born preterm (<37 weeks' gestational age) commonly experience chronic respiratory disease, poor feedi1ng and growth, neurosensory impairments, and delays in cognitive and motor development through infancy and early childhood.\(^{1-7}\) Perinatal morbidities such as necrotizing enterocolitis and intracranial hemorrhage may amplify these risks.\(^{8}\) Therefore, it is not surprising that high-risk infants experience high rates of special health care needs, using health services, prescription medication, and medical technology at rates far greater than their term-born peers.\(^{9}\) Even preterm infants without significant morbidities require specialized follow-up by multiple providers—primary care pediatricians, high-risk infant follow-up (HRIF) programs, early intervention (EI) providers, and audiologists, to name but a few.\(^{10,11}\)
