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Across Greenland's Ice Cap Alfred de Quervain, 2022-05-15 As polar exploration reached its zenith and in the same month that Captain Robert Falcon Scott perished in Antarctica four young scientists from Zurich took ship for Greenland Though they had little previous experience of arctic travel their ambition was to achieve the first west to east crossing of the northern hemisphere's largest ice cap making scientific observations along the way Few outside Switzerland have heard of this expedition or its leader the meteorologist Alfred de Quervain in spite of its success In thirty one days in the summer of 1912 the party sledged across 640 kilometres of untracked snow and ice Nobody died or fell into a crevasse although there were
