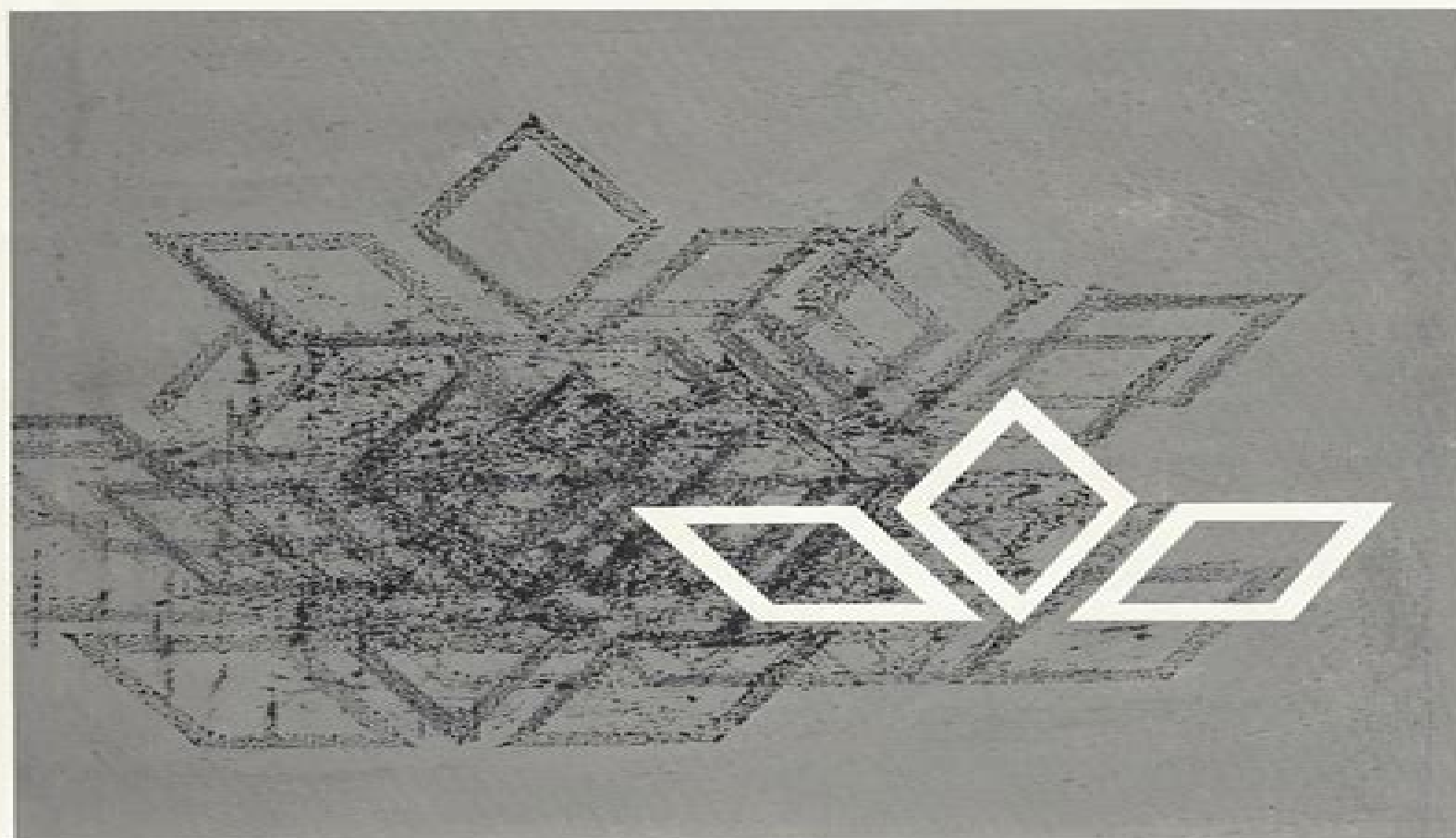

Andrew Johnson, 2024-09-17 A compelling study into the history and lasting influence of enslaved Native people in early South Carolina In 1708 the governor of South Carolina responded to a request from London to describe the population of the colony This response included an often overlooked segment of the population Native Americans who made up one fourth of all enslaved people in the colony Yet it was not long before these descriptions of enslaved Native people all but disappeared from the archive In *Enslaved Native Americans and the Making of Colonial South Carolina* D Andrew Johnson argues that Native people were crucial to the development of South Carolina s economy and culture By meticulously scouring documentary sources and creating a database of over 15 000 mentions of enslaved people Johnson uses a uniquely interdisciplinary approach to reconsider the history of South Carolina and center the enslaved Native people who were forced to live and work on its plantations Johnson also employs spatial analysis and examines archaeological evidence to study Native slavery in a plantation context Although much of their impact is absent from the historical record Native people s influence persisted in the specific technologies they brought to the plantations where they were enslaved in the development of Creole culture and in the wealth and power of the founders and early leaders of the colony This book is an important corrective to our understanding of the colonization and development of South Carolina By focusing on the Native minority of the enslaved population Johnson recasts the colonial history of America uncovering the importance of enslaved Native people to the colonial project and the complex historical connections between race and slavery [The Grim Years](#) John J. South Carolinians lived in continual fear For some it was the price they paid for financial success But for most there were no riches and the possibility of a sudden violent death was overshadowed by the misery of their day to day existence

Greene, 2004-01-21 In this book Jack Greene reinterprets the meaning of American social development Synthesizing literature of the previous two decades on the process of social development and the formation of American culture he challenges the central assumptions that have traditionally been used to analyze colonial British American history Greene argues that the New England declension model traditionally employed by historians is inappropriate for describing social change in all the other early modern British colonies The settler societies established in Ireland the Atlantic island colonies of Bermuda and the Bahamas the West Indies the Middle Colonies and the Lower South followed instead a pattern first exhibited in America in the Chesapeake That pattern involved a process in which these new societies slowly developed into more elaborate cultural entities each of which had its own distinctive features Greene also stresses the social and cultural convergence between New England and the other regions of colonial British America after 1710 and argues that by the eve of the American Revolution Britain's North American colonies were both more alike and more like the parent society than ever before He contends as well that the salient features of an emerging American culture during these years are to be found not primarily in New England puritanism but in widely manifest configurations of sociocultural behavior exhibited throughout British North America including New England and he emphasized the centrality of slavery to that culture
