



Ecological-reserve areas of general value to the environment and to the type, quality and quantity of environmental resources. This study depicts revisions of ecoregions originally compiled in a similarly small-scale (1:1,000,000) by the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS). In response to a call for revision of the project, members of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Environmental Monitoring Laboratory Co-located with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) began work in 1990 to refine the original 1:1,000,000-scale USGS ecoregions. In 1992 and 1993, DEP personnel, after input from USGS scientists, revised the original 1:1,000,000-scale USGS ecoregions to reflect changes in land-use patterns and ecological processes. The revised map is intended to facilitate use in conservation and management efforts in the state. The revisions are being used as a starting point for developing the first comprehensive natural resource management plan for the state. The revised map also provides a framework for assessing the status and trends of natural resources in the state and for developing management guidelines for conserving and protecting natural resources. The methodology used to develop the ecoregions is given by Oberndorfer, et al. (1993), Oberndorfer, et al. (1995), and Oberndorfer and Petrone (1996).
