newspapers a money back guarantee if his prediction that Franklin Delano Roosevelt would win wasn t more accurate Gallup believed that public opinion polls served an important function in a democracy If govern ment is supposed to be based on the will of the people somebody ought to go and find what that will is Gallup explained
