victory of Donald Trump as the S President has represented an ideological shift from free trade advocator of global capitalism to a mixture of right wing populism Before and after the presidential election he called for the revival of the American economy which has been under considerable pressure since 2008 World Recession In order to prove growth rate Trump has a huge challenge ahead not least to deal with the competition from South East Asian economies especially China It remains to be seen whether the new US administration will continue with their populist rhetoric In this book Economic Impacts of Globalization Growth Development several academicians provide different analysis of economic growth and economic development.
