You think you "don't have time" to start my day with meditation, but that's like saying, "I don't have time to get gas before I go on this long road trip!" You have to fill yourself up first before you have anything to give.

MORNING

8:00am: My alarm goes off, I brush my teeth, scrape my tongue to get rid of all the toxins released overnight and have some water (not in the winter, room temperature in the summer).

8:10am: I get moving with 10-15 minutes of yoga and/or Ayurvedic exercises to wake up my body.

8:30am: I do The Ziva Technique—mindfulness, meditation and manifesting. This is the only non-negotiable self-care habit that I have. The others I will mix and match depending on season or level of demand in my life.

8:50am: I use the 5 Minute Journal to write 3 things I'm grateful for, 3 things that would make today great, and 3 things I want to accomplish today.

9:00am: Breastfeeding/playtime with my son, Jasper.

9:30am: I have my favorite superfood smoothie and take all my supplements, including a prebiotic/probiotic, cod liver oil and vitamins C and D. Shout out to my husband who makes said smoothie while I breastfeed. #teamwork

10:30am: Leave for work at Ziva in Soho, Manhattan, or I sit down at my laptop to work at home for the day. My work days vary, and I have to be ready for anything from meeting with my team to getting interviewed for a podcast, doing a video shoot, or teaching a roomful of people The Ziva Technique!
