The boy was George Bizos. Today, George Bizos is a legendary name renowned throughout the legal profession and beyond. More than that, he is a figure recognised in townships across South Africa. For as an advocate, Bizos is associated with the Treason Trial of the late 1950s, the subsequent Rivonia Trial where his colleague, client and friend Nelson Mandela was sentenced to life imprisonment, the trial of Bram Fischer, that of the Namibian Toivo ja Toivo, a host of major human rights trials through the 1970s and 1980s right up to the amnesty hearings of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission, and in 2004 with the treason trial of the Zimbabwean opposition leader Morgan Tsvangirai in that country. A consummate lawyer, a self-styled street fighter with a quiet tone of voice and a beguiling smile, who in cross-examination would slice through the evidence of security police and apartheid apologists alike, Bizos haunted the courtrooms of the apartheid regime. For four decades, he exposed State lies and hypocrisy, State brutality and murder. In response, the State
