Her career took her from charity organization leadership in Baltimore and Philadelphia to an executive position with the prestigious Russell Sage Foundation in New York City Richmond's progressive civic philosophy of social work was largely informed by the social gospel movement She strove to find practical applications of the teachings of Christianity in response to the social problems that accompanied rapid
