Facs. of the 1495 Venice ed** Johannes Ketham, Petrus (de Tussignano; Mundinus; Morsianus, Petrus Andreas.), 1976 **The Anatomists' Library** Colin Salter, 2023-07-20 The Anatomist's Library is a fascinating chronological collection of the best anatomical books from six centuries charting the evolution of both medical knowledge and illustrated publishing There is a rich history of medical publishing across Europe with outstanding publications from Germany France Italy Netherlands Spain UK and also many from Persia and Japan Because of the high value of accurate medical textbooks it was these works that pushed the boundaries of illustrated publishing They commanded the expert illustrators and skilled engravers and hence didn't come cheaply They were treasured by libraries and their intrinsic worth has meant that there is an incredible wealth of beautifully preserved historic examples from the 15th century onwards The enduring popularity of Gray's Anatomy has shown that there is a long term interest in the subject beyond the necessity of medical students to learn the modern equivalent the 42nd edition 2020 from cover to cover But Englishman Henry Gray was late in the field and never saw the enduring success of his famous work Having first published the surgeon's reference book in 1858 he died in 1861 after contracting smallpox from his nephew who survived He was just 34 Gray was following on from a long tradition of anatomists starting with Aristotle and Galen whose competing theories about the human body dominated early medicine
