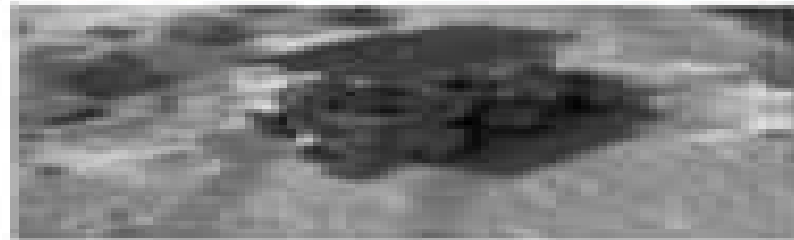

He shows how these missions employed smaller spacecraft and cheaper technology to undertake less complex and more specific tasks in outer space. While the technological innovation and space exploration approach that McCurdy describes is still controversial, the historical perspective on its disappointments and triumphs points to ways of developing faster, better, and cheaper as a management manifesto. Readers interested in either the management or economics of complex organizations will find a wealth of material in this well-written exposition.
