Stamper, 1991-08-27 Since its opening in the 1920s Chicago s North Michigan Avenue has been one of the city s most prestigious commerical corridors lined by some of its most architecturally distinctive business residential and hotel buildings Planned by Daniel Burnham in 1909 the avenue became the principal

connecting link between downtown and the wealthy residential Gold Coast north of the Loop. His argument that the discrepancies between the rejected plans and reality illustrate the developers' choice of economic return on their investment over aesthetic community is extended through to the present avenue and the virtual disregard of the urban qualities proposed at its inception. Generously illustrated with an epilogue condensing the avenue's history between the end of World War II and the present, this is an exhaustive account of an important topic in the history of modern architecture and city planning.
