Historia de la Universidad Central del Ecuador y su participación en la independencia de Quito (siglos XVI-XIX) Rex Tipton Sosa Freire,2021-12-01 Las Américas de los siglos XVI XVIII constituyeron territorios periféricos dentro del ámbito general de la Monarquía hispánica Las iniciativas académicas que se plantearon en ellos tomaron como referencia las soluciones peninsulares de la metrópoli el modelo de Convento Universidad vinculado a órdenes religiosos concretas y el modelo corporativo Claustral más complejo significativo en Salamanca y aplicado en los centros administrativos virreinales de Lima y México a las universidades de patronato regio allí fundadas Sin embargo el modelo de Colegio Universidad no parece que contara con patronos privados de suficiente garantía y estabilidad económica Pues bien las universidades hispanoamericanas

fueron evolucionando al calor de fuertes intereses locales vinculadas a las clerecías y a los oficios medios de la administración colonial Salamanca Universidad prototípica del modelo Claustro corporativo en el ámbito cultural hispano estuvo más presente en Lima y México que en las restantes universidades conventuales de la América hispana pero el patrón salmantino se readaptó a posteriormente y se irracionalizando a las circunstancias concretas de los territorios ultramarinos Rex Tipton estudia la constitución de la Junta Central de Quito en 1809 y los sangrientos enfrentamientos de agosto de 1810 las facciones entre partidarios de la Monarquía y republicanos el Congreso constitucional de 1812 y las confrontaciones de los insurgentes con tropas realistas Para 1822 la Universidad acuerda prescindir de las armas reales en su escudo y como Universidad Central se remodela a partir de 1832 Así pues en la Independencia la Universidad contribuye a la emancipación mental y el ejército y el apoyo extranjero a la política pasando el control y gobierno a los criollos americanos Luis Enrique Rodríguez San Pedro Bezares *Dominación ideológica y ciencia social* Colegio de Etnólogos y Antropólogos Sociales, A.C.
