- Referred to acting as "playing."
 "Acting" was reserved for the movements and gestures of speakers.
- Short rehearsals periods and large number of plays performed so characters were not thought through like actors today.
- Players were usually given only their characters' speeches and not the whole play script.
- Players were male! Always!
- After 1600 players became a recognize profession with a guild and apprentice system.
- Players were fairly well educated for their time. Acting was taught in grammar school and they had to be able to read and write.
