During dreams, the preconscious is more lax in this duty than in waking hours but is still attentive, so such the unconscious must distort and warp the meaning of its information to make it through the censorship. As such, images in dreams are often not what they appear to be, according to Freud, and need deeper interpretation if they are to inform on the structures of the unconscious.
