her 4 Mary s her ladies in waiting who were her constant companions at court and during her long years of imprisonment where they just sat quietly throughout the day embroidering pieces of fine art Needlepoint is normally done on canvas which is a sturdy fabric built to last It is an open weave fabric It is used as a basic framework for the stitches that you are going to work into it It is available in a large number of weaves and the sizes are arranged according to the number of threads present vertically per inch
