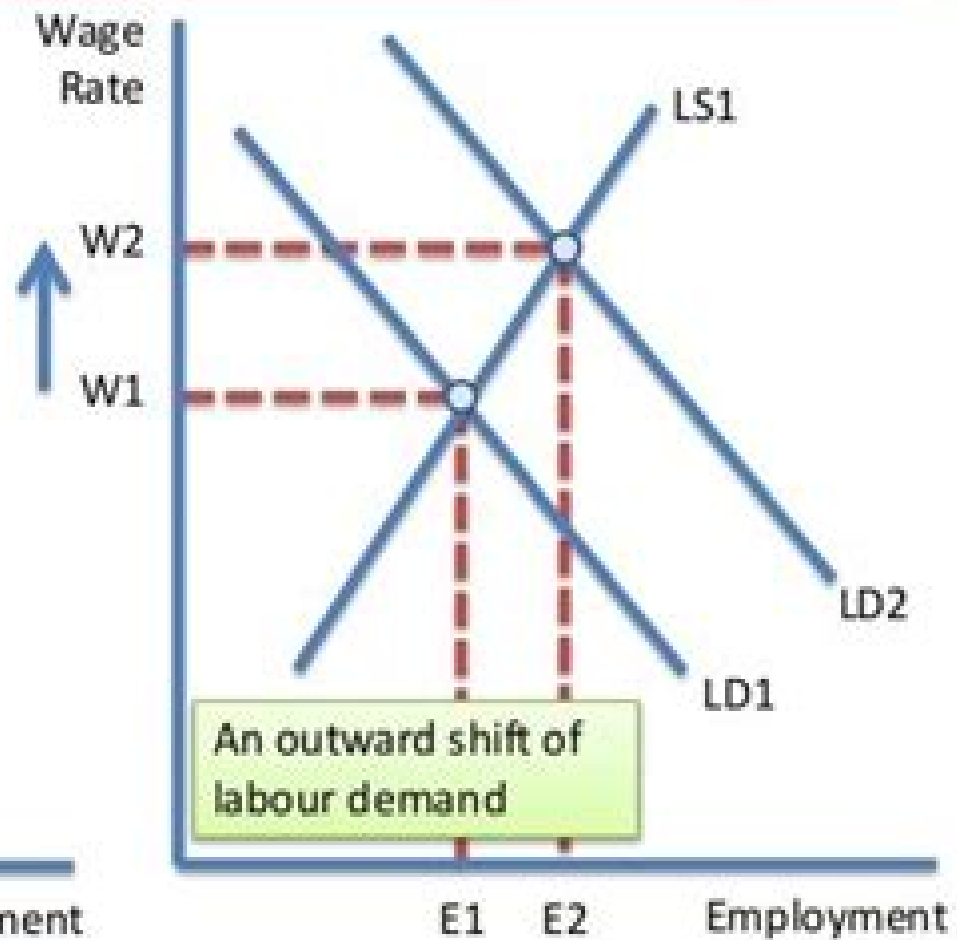
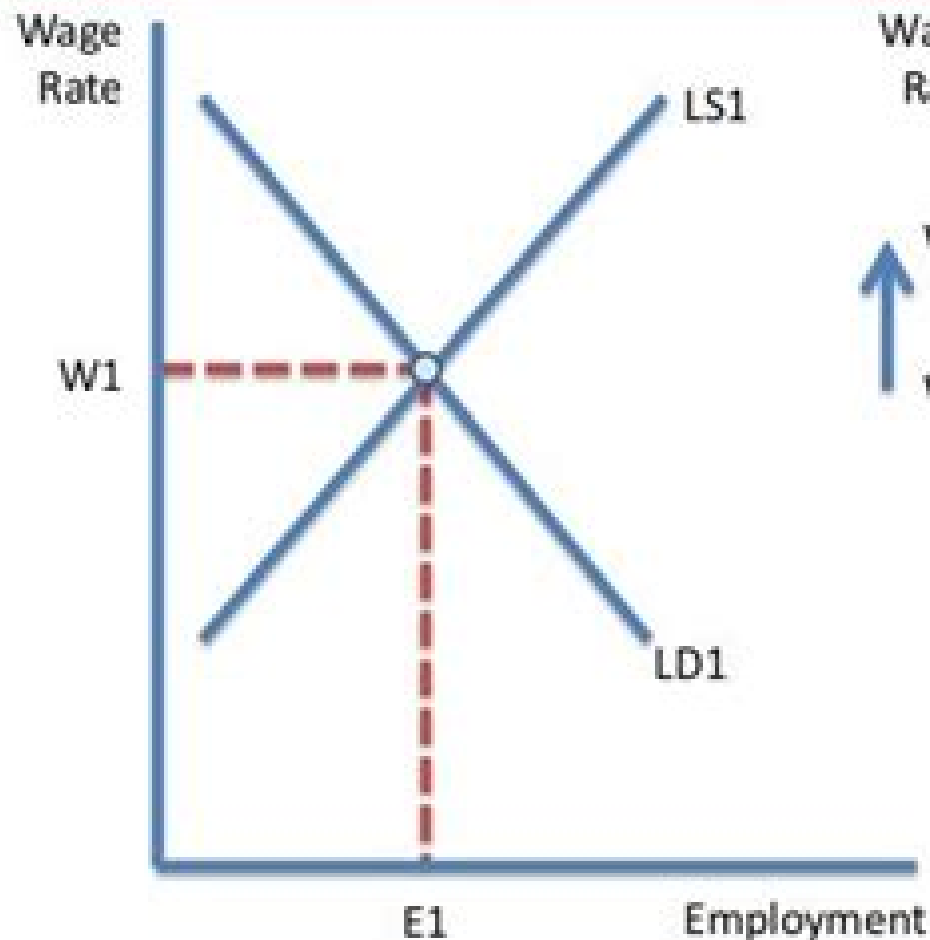


Equilibrium Wages in the Labour Market
