bedeutet Heimat für die deutschsprachigen jüdischen Flüchtlinge die durch das nationalsozialistische Terrorregime aus ihrer zentraleuropäischen Heimat vertrieben wurden und sich in Palästina angesiedelt haben. Dieser Frage geht diese Studie nach. Der 77 qualitative Interviews zu Grunde liegen in denen persönliche Lebensgeschichten sowie der Prozess der Beheimatung in Palästina/Israel thematisiert werden. Zionistische Visionen und der Traum von einer besseren Gesellschaft sind dabei zentral. Es wird deutlich dass Brüche in den Biografien und Entwurzelung eine Lokalisierung von Heimat erschweren vielmehr ist die parallele Existenz mehrerer Heimaten in verschiedenen Kulturumfeldern für die meisten der befragten Personen selbstverständlich.

From Christian Hebraism to Jewish Studies: Johannes Buxtorf (1564-1629) and Hebrew Learning in the Seventeenth Century Stephen Burnett, 2021-12-06 This book examines how Johannes Buxtorf's works helped to transform seventeenth century Hebrew studies from the hobby of a few experts into a recognized academic discipline. The first two chapters examine Buxtorf's career as a professor of Hebrew and as an editor and censor of Jewish books in Basel. Successive chapters analyze his anti-Jewish polemical books, grammars and lexicons and manuals for Hebrew composition and literature including the first bibliography devoted to Jewish books. The final chapters treat his work in biblical studies examining his contribution to Targum and Massorah studies and his position on the age and doctrinal authority of the Hebrew vowel points. The chapters on anti-Jewish polemics and the vowel points will interest Jewish historians and Church historians.

Das Gastspiel Sebastian Schirrmeyer, 2012-05-15 Friedrich Lobe 1889-1958 gehörte zu den wenigen aus Deutschland geflüchteten Theatermachern die im hebräischen Theater in Palästina Fuß fassen konnten. Nach seiner Einwanderung 1933 für eine erste Inszenierung von Dantons Tod am Tel Aviv Arbeitertheater Ohel engagiert führte Lobe bis zu seiner Rückkehr nach Europa 1950 bei drei Produktionen Regie. veröffentlichte zahlreiche Zeitungsartikel und schrieb nicht zuletzt zwölf eigene dramatische Texte. Auf Grundlage umfangreicher Archivrecherchen untersucht Sebastian Schirrmeyer erstmals die besonderen Konstellationen die sich aus Lobes Emigration nach Palästina ergaben und die sich in seinen Aktivitäten und Texten widerspiegeln. Ein arrivierter deutscher Theaterkünstler traf auf ein im Aufbau befindliches von russischen Emigranten und zionistischer Ideologie beherrschtes hebräisches Theater. Er musste sich in der neuen Umgebung die sich im Spannungsfeld von Migration, Kulturtransfer und der Konstruktionsarbeit an einer neuen Nationalkultur konstituierte behaupten. Ein einst bekannter Schauspieler wurde der Sprache des Landes nicht mehr mächtig zum Dramatiker und konnte nur mithilfe von Übersetzung und Maskerade Eingang in das bereits besetzte kulturelle Feld finden. Die Tatsache dass Lobe bislang weder im deutschen noch im israelischen Forschungskontext Beachtung fand ist sicherlich der Ungleichheit einer eindeutigen nationalen Zuordnung seines Wirkens seiner ambivalenten Position zwischen allen Stühlen geschuldet.

Jewish Culture and Society in Medieval France and Germany Ivan G. Marcus, 2023-04-14 These studies explore the history of the Jewish minority of Ashkenaz northern France and the German Empire during the High Middle Ages Although the Jews in medieval Europe are usually thought to have been isolated from the Christian majority they actually were part of a Jewish Christian symbiosis A number of studies in the collection focus on Jewish Christian cultural and social interactions the foundations of the community ascribed to Charlemagne and especially on the fashioning of a martyrological collective identity in 1096 Even when Jews resisted Christian pressures they often did so by internalizing Christian motifs and turning them on their heads to argue for the truth of Judaism alone This may be seen especially in the formation of Jews as martyrs a trope that places Jews as collective Christ figures whose suffering brings about vicarious atonement The remainder of the studies delve into the lives and writings of a group of Jewish ascetic pietists Hasidei Ashkenaz which shaped the religious culture of most European Jews before modernity In Sefer Hasidim Book of the Pietists attributed to Rabbi Judah the Pietist of Regensburg d 1217 one finds a mirror of everyday Jewish Christian interactions even while the author advances a radical view of Jewish religious pietism
