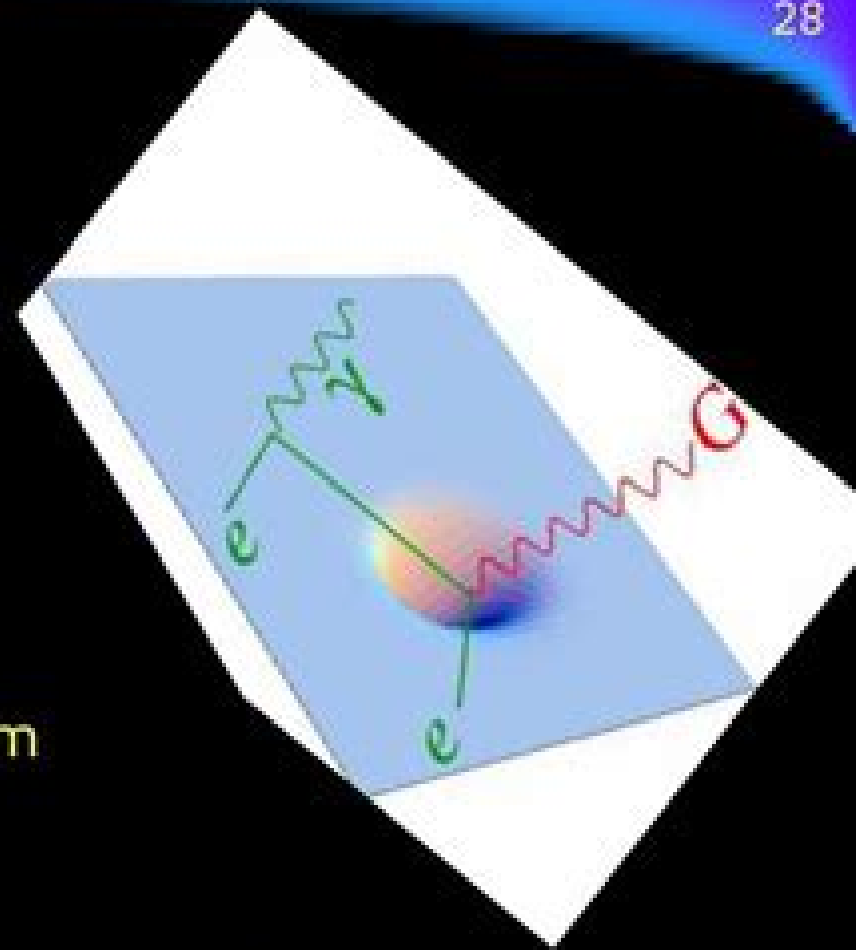


Finding extra spatial dimensions
