A Face in the Rock Loren R. Graham, 1995-06 Tells the story of the Grand Island Chippewa Indians and also presents a morality play about the plight of populations destroyed by the violence of other cultures **Face in the Rock** Loren R. Graham, 1998 Eight miles long and four miles wide Grand Island lies off the south shore of Lake Superior It was once home to a sizable community of Chippewa Indians who lived in harmony with the land and with each other Their tragic demise began early in the nineteenth century when their fellow tribesmen from the mainland goaded them into waging war against rival Sioux The war party was decimated only one young brave Powers of the Air lived to tell the story that celebrated the heroism of his band and formed the basis of the legend that survives today Distinguished historian Loren R Graham has spent more than forty years researching and reconstructing the poignant tale of Powers of the Air and his people *A Face in the Rock* is an artful melding of human history and natural history it is a fascinating narrative of the intimate relation between place and people Powers of the Air lived to witness the desecration of Grand Island by the fur and logging industries the Christianization of the tribe and the near total loss of the Chippewa language history and culture Graham charts the plight of the Chippewa as white culture steadily encroaches forcing the native people off the island and dispersing their community on the mainland The story ends with happier events of the past two decades including the protection of Grand Island within the National Forest system and the resurgence of Chippewa culture **A Face in the Rock** Loren R. who has told me several of these stories He is also the author of *A Face In The Rock The Tale Of A Grand Island Chippewa*

Michigan Indian Boarding School Survivors Speak Out Sharon Marie Brunner, 2024 Winner of U P Notable Book Award 2025 The impact of Indian boarding schools has been devastating for generations of Native Americans and the aftershocks continue to affect their descendants today Michigan was home to three in Baraga Harbor Springs and Mt Pleasant The last to close was Holy Childhood School of Jesus in Harbor Springs in 1983 Sharon Marie Brunner set out to intensively study the family history and boarding school experience of nine Native American survivors who attended either the Mt Pleasant or Harbor Springs institutions Each faced problems linked to the scars of this experience although their recollections included positive and negative reports A woman whose mother attended one of these institutions and a member of the Sault Ste Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians Brunner is uniquely positioned to understand the cultural background Brunner deftly teases out the themes from in person interviews transcribed in 2001 Surprising similarities and differences are explored in this highly researched social work treatise Abuses are documented in the hope that we can prevent such a calamity from ever happening again Whether or not you have any Native American heritage this book is crucial to understanding the lived experience of our fellow human beings and how we can do better Social workers educators and those in human services must read this book to develop policies that address the unique challenges and

Nye,2004-09-17 An exploration of the dialogue

that emerged after 1776 between different visions of what it meant to use new technologies to transform the land After 1776 the former American colonies began to reimagine themselves as a unified self created community Technologies had an important role in the resulting national narratives and a few technologies assumed particular prominence Among these were the axe the mill the canal the railroad and the irrigation dam In this book David Nye explores the stories that clustered around these technologies In doing so he rediscovers an American story of origins with America conceived as a second creation built in harmony with God s first creation While mainstream Americans constructed technological foundation stories to explain their place in the New World however marginalized groups told other stories of destruction and loss Native Americans protested the loss of their forests fishermen resisted the construction of dams and early environmentalists feared the exhaustion of resources A water mill could be viewed as the kernel of a new community or as a new way to exploit labor If passengers comprehended railways as part of a larger narrative about American expansion and progress many farmers attacked railroad land grants To explore these contradictions Nye devotes alternating chapters to narratives of second creation and to narratives of those who rejected it Nye draws on popular literature speeches advertisements paintings and many other media to create a history of American foundation stories He shows how these stories were revised periodically as social and economic conditions changed without ever erasing the earlier stories entirely The image of the isolated frontier family carving a homestead out of the wilderness with an axe persists to this day alongside later images and narratives In the book s conclusion Nye considers the relation between these earlier stories and such later American developments as the conservation movement narratives of environmental recovery and the idealization of wilderness
