Far Eastern Literatures in the 20th Century: a guide. [Harpenden: Oldcastle Books, 1988. 197 pp.]

Selected from a larger work, the *Encyclopaedia of World Literature*, the *Guide to Far Eastern Literatures* contains introductory essays and biographical sketches of reasonably contemporary writers. Seventeen Chinese writers are included, compared with 25 Japanese, three Korean and three Philippine writers, and some literatures, like those of Outer Mongolia and Cambodia are merely described, with no biographies.

The choice of Chinese writers is conservative and somewhat out of date with Ai Ch'ing (Ai Qing) and Ts'ao Yu (Cao Yu), both of whom were born in 1910, the youngest representatives.

The bibliographies listing critical works in English are useful, though out of date, but the lists of "further works" (merely titles in Wade-Giles, with a date) are quite meaningless to non-Chinese speakers for whom the work is presumably intended. It is also unfortunate that virtually none of the available translations of the writers' works is listed. As the *Guide* is presumably intended for students of comparative literature, it would have been helpful to indicate examples for comparison.
