Chapter 1: Globalization and place - the death of geography

La globalizzazione ammette diverse prospettive e visioni. È un'idea o un'insieme di idee contestata. Ci sono, comunque, pochi dubbi sul fatto che, dagli anni '80 (1980), siamo entrati in una diversa fase nello sviluppo e nel processo di industrializzazione. Un importante fattore chiave è la rivoluzione del XX secolo nel trasporto e nella tecnologia delle comunicazioni. Oggi è possibile, ad esempio, circumnavigare il mondo in solo più di un giorno su voli commerciali. Meno che 50 anni fa, il viaggio dall'Inghilterra all'Australia durava circa una settimana. Nel 1870, ci sarebbero voluti 70 giorni perché la posta ordinaria raggiungesse la Nuova Zelanda partita da Londra. Con l'avvento di telefoni, computer, fotocamere digitali, email e simili, tali comunicazioni sono diventate quasi istantanee. Quando parliamo l'immobilità (fixity) dei libri e degli artefatti in una libreria all'accessibilità che è garantita da motori di ricerca come Google, enciclopedie online come Wikipedia e tecnologie per la condivisione dei video come Youtube, capiamo che il mondo è cambiato. Viviamo in un villaggio globale "global village" e il termine che è più comunemente usato per riferirsi a questa apparente riduzione è globalizzazione. Sempre più usato per razionalizzare una larga gamma di politiche economiche e politiche e per spiegare una pletora di processi e risultati culturali, sociali e economici, il concetto di globalizzazione ha assunto enorme potere. Questo concetto implica anche un diverso modo di concepire il mondo in cui viviamo, una dimensione culturale (si riferisce all'intensificazione e all'espansione dei flussi culturali attraverso il mondo. Facilitato da Internet e da dispositivi mobili digitali sempre più diffusi, il dominante sistema simbolico di significato del nostro tempo - come individualismo, consumismo e discorsi religiosi - possono essere più facilmente e velocemente trasmessi da un posto all'altro e ha colpito profondamente il modo in cui le persone sperimentano le vite quotidiane).

Un'immagine comune della globalizzazione è quella di un processo che si svolge come una coperta sul mondo (a process that unfolds like a blanket across the globe), un processo di omogeneizzazione (a process of homogenization) delle economie, società e culture mondiali. Tutto si somiglia (everywhere becomes the same), le linee di confine non hanno importanza (boundaries do not matter, il mondo sta diventando piatto) e le distanze scompaiono (distance disappears, la distanza non è più un fattore che influenza l'organizzazione spaziale delle attività; per esempio, le attività possono muoversi liberamente "footlose").

La geografia come disciplina, campo di studi: la geografia ha qualcosa da dire sulla globalizzazione? La geografia come differenza geografica, differenziazione spaziale: la differenziazione geografica (la diversità di luoghi) è ancora importante in un periodo in cui tutto sembrava essere lo stesso? (Cartone 1.1: in un'agenzia di viaggio, ci sono posters di diverse città in diverse parti del mondo. La particolarità è che i posters sono praticamente identici, hanno la stessa composizione di edifici, occupati dalle medesime multinazionali come Sony, Coca Cola, McDonalds'.) C'è stata la diffusione di un globale sistema di valori: compriamo le stesse cose ovunque, i centri commerciali sono onnipresenti, vendono marchi globali e sono l'icona di un'economia e una cultura globalizzata. La morte della geografia è stata predetta per quasi quattro decenni. Più recentemente, il sottotitolo di Global Financial Integration di O'Brien proclamò la fine della geografia come una situazione che implica uno stato di sviluppo economico dove la posizione geografica non ha più importanza (a state of economic development where geographical location no longer matters). Non c'è dubbio che, rispetto al passato, persone e processi in "luoghi distanti" possono avere impatti "locali" quasi istantanei. Geografi e altri studiosi hanno usato diverse espressioni per questo processo includendo sterminio dello spazio dal tempo (annihilation of space by time), convergenza spazio-tempo (time-space convergence), compressione spazio-tempo (time-space compression) e l'allarmante velocità di contagio economico e finanziario (economic and financial contagion), che è diventato un nuovo termine in voga nei settori finanziari; per esempio, la crisi asiatica del 1997 si diffuse velocemente nella regione dell'Asia Pacifica dalla Thailandia al Sud Corea e al Giappone. Le ramificazioni del collasso ebbero un rapido e tangibile impatto sulle economie di tutto il mondo a diversi gradi. Ma questa diminuzione sembrava penetrare in tutte le sfere dell'attività umana (concetto del mondo che si restringe: il mondo sta diventando sempre più piccolo e sempre più connesso). I media e i telegiornali, come la CNN e la BBC, trasmisero eventi, come l'indomani dello tsunami del 2004 nell'Oceano Indiano, in tempo reale nelle case e negli uffici delle persone in tutto il
