10,000 BCE
Agricultural Revolution
(Neolithic Revolution)

This period marked the transition from hunter-gatherer societies to settled agricultural communities, where people started cultivating crops and domesticating animals for food. The cultivation of staple crops like wheat, rice, and maize laid the foundation for the development of complex human societies and various culinary traditions.



500BCE – 500CE
Ancient Greek and Roman Cuisine
