Vatican II doc. L. G. 1: Christ prayed for this unity amongst his adherents in accordance with the unity between him and God the Father. Cf. Jn 17:21. The present religious crises in Nigeria have escalated to an issue of grave concern with the Boko Haram insurgency. My motivation is to demonstrate the teaching of the Church regarding interdenominational and interreligious dialogue within Nigeria. There has been no sustained effort to build bridges of religious unity in the country. This research will demonstrate the necessity of ecumenical
