Right to Education

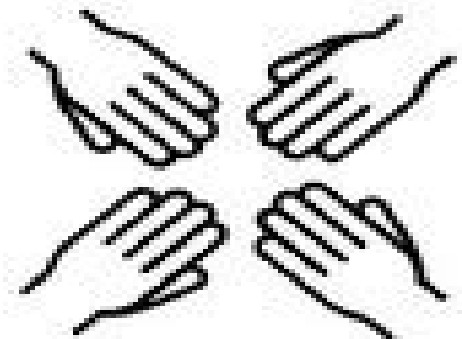
Right to education means that everyone has access to compulsory primary education. It also refers to the right of everyone to higher education and the without charge.
