equal opportunities to secure a better quality of life One further danger may lie in regarding ethnicities as fixed rather than as the potentially fluid phenomena that they often are Situational ethnicity does occur and individuals and groups do modify their self identifications depending on circumstances Please note that the terminology in the fields of minority rights and indigenous peoples rights has changed over time MRG strives to reflect these changes as well as respect the right to self identification on the part of minorities and indigenous peoples At the same time after over 50 years work we know that our archive is of considerable interest to activists and researchers Therefore we make available as much of our back catalogue as possible while being aware that the language used may not reflect current thinking on these issues
