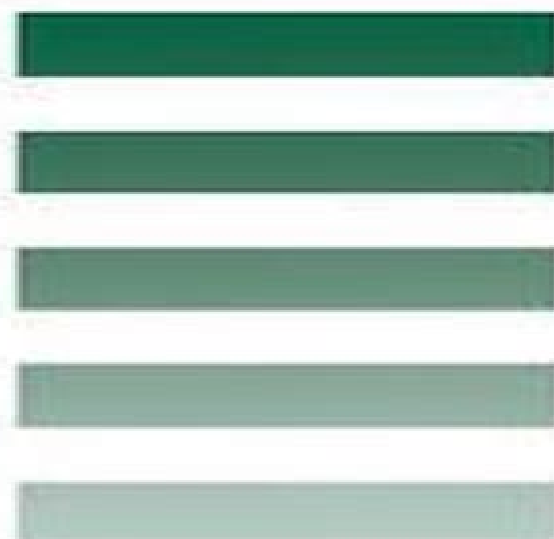

**Nitrogen Turnover in the Soil-Crop System**

J.J. Groot, P. de Willigen, E.J. Verberne, 2012-12-06

In the Netherlands the Institute for Soil Fertility Research plays a major role in soil biological, soil physical, and plant nutritional research on the availability of nitrogen to crops. Main subjects of research are nitrogen turnover in the crop-soil ecosystem through biological transformations, nitrogen transport through the soil, and nitrogen losses by leaching, denitrification, and volatilization, and nitrogen use efficiency of various crops and cropping systems. The current knowledge in the different fields of research is integrated in simulation models. Simulation models not only make it possible to summarize and structure knowledge but also, after verification, to extrapolate the knowledge to situations different from the situations that have actually been studied. Such research is also carried out in other European and non-European countries. To compare the various simulation models currently in use, a workshop was organized by the Institute for Soil Fertility Research on 5-6 June 1990 on the occasion of its centennial. The title of the workshop was Nitrogen turnover in the soil-crop ecosystem: modelling of biological transformations, transport of nitrogen, and nitrogen use efficiency. The 40 participants who came from Canada and various European countries were requested to run their model with data provided by the Institute prior to the workshop. Data from 18 cases were made available to the participants: three locations, three treatments, and two seasons.

**Plant-Soil Interactions at Low pH** Robert J. Wright, V.C. Baligar, R. Paul Murrmann, 2012-12-06

Soil acidity is a major limitation to crop production in many parts of the world. Plant growth inhibition results from a combination of factors including aluminum, manganese, and hydrogen ion toxicities and deficiencies of essential elements, particularly calcium, magnesium, phosphorus, and molybdenum. Agricultural management practices and acid precipitation have increased acid inputs into the ecosystem and heightened concern about soil acidity problems. While application of lime has proved to be effective in ameliorating surface soil acidity in many areas, significant soil acidity problems still exist. Scientists from Alberta, Canada, recognized the need to provide a forum for researchers from different disciplines to exchange information and ideas on solving problems of plant growth in acid soils. As a result of their

efforts the First International Symposium on Plant Soil Interactions at Low pH was held at Grande Prairie Alberta Canada in July 1987 In many acid soil areas liming materials are not readily available the cost may be prohibitive or subsoil acidity cannot be corrected by surface application of lime New management approaches involving both the plant and the soil are needed in these situations Progress has been made in the selection and breeding of acid tolerant plants However continued progress will be limited by our lack of understanding of the physiological and biochemical basis of differential acidity tolerance among plants

**Iron Nutrition in Soils and Plants** Javier Abadía, 2012-12-06 Iron is a major constituent of the earth crust However under alkaline conditions commonly found in arid and semi arid environments iron becomes unavailable to plants When plants are affected by a shortage of iron their leaves become yellow chlorotic and both plant growth and crop yield are reduced The roots of plants affected by iron deficiency may develop a series of responses directed to improve iron uptake such as increased proton excretion and iron reduction capabilities or excretion of iron chelators

called siderophores Iron deficiency affects major crops worldwide including some of major economic importance such as fruit trees and others Correction of iron deficiency is usually implemented through costly application of synthetic chelates Since these correction methods are very expensive the competitiveness of farmers is often reduced and iron deficiency may become a limiting factor for the maintenance introduction or expansion of some crops In spite of the many years devoted to the study of iron deficiency the knowledge of iron deficiency in soils and plants is still fragmentary in many aspects We have only incomplete information on the processes at the molecular level that make some plant species and cultivars unable to take and utilize iron from the soil whereas other plants grow satisfactorily under the same conditions Symbiotic Nitrogen Fixation
