This is a much needed perspective which is ignored by most researchers and users of such databases and even if centered in the NOW database the lessons that can be learned from this part can be extended to other examples After this introductory part the body of the book follows and is divided into three parts patterns in regional faunas large scale patterns and processes and ecological biogeographical and evolutionary patterns of key taxa Each chapter is written by well known specialists in the field with some participation of members of the NOW advisory board The array of selected mammal taxa ranges from carnivores equids ruminants and rodents to the genus Homo The topics studied also include the diversification and radiation of major clades large scale paleobiogeographical patterns the evolution of ecomorphological patterns and paleobiological problems such as evolution of body size or species longevity In most cases the results are discussed in relation to protracted environmental or paleogeographic changes
