

To this end Aquinas cites proofs for the existence of God and outlines the activities and nature of God. Approximately one half of the Summa Theologica then examines the nature and purpose of man. Finally Aquinas devotes his attention to the nature of Christ and the role of the Sacraments in effecting a bridge between God and man. Within these broad topical boundaries though Aquinas examines the nature of God and man in exquisite detail. His examination includes questions of how angels act on bodies, the union of body and soul, the cause and remedies of anger, cursing, and the comparison of one sin with another.
