The public, deeply divided over who was guilty, was troubled by evidence that suggested not only that fair might be foul but that it might not be possible to decide which was which. While the decade of the 1770s has most frequently been studied in relation to imperial concerns and their impact upon the political institutions of the day, this book draws a different portrait of the period, making a case for its point of entry.
